# BOLOGNA FOLLOW-UP GROUP (BFUG) MEETING XCIII – VENUES

- The predecessor of the university, Hungarian Royal National School of Arts and Crafts, was founded in 1880 and operated under this name until 1944.
- The university's current name, Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design (MOME), was announced in 2006.
- With the creation of the new Campus, MOME has been given a home with a level of technology meeting 21st century expectations.
- MOME's core activities are organised into three major structural pillars: the Academy, the Innovation Center, and the TechPark. Along with the MOME Library.



# BOLOGNA FOLLOW-UP GROUP (BFUG) MEETING XCIII – VENUES



- The reception will take place at the charming Ybl-villa on 25<sup>th</sup> September.
- The Ybl Villa was already mentioned among the most beautiful villas in Buda 150 years ago, in the 1850s. Surrounded by a park of ancient trees, the monument bears the imprint of Miklós Ybl's hand.
- The villa was one of the first examples of the Neo-Renaissance movement in the capital, as evidenced by its harmonious architectural proportions and its magnificent Renaissance lodge.
- The villa's three floors lead the visitor from the spectacular wine cellar in the patinated cellar to the three dazzling interconnecting salons on the mezzanine level and the fabulous comfort of the luxury guest rooms upstairs.

- The Gala Dinner will take place in the National Museum.
- The Hungarian National Museum (Hungarian: Magyar Nemzeti Múzeum) was founded in 1802 and is the national museum for the history, art, and archaeology of Hungary, including areas not within Hungary's modern borders, such as Transylvania.
- The museum is in Budapest VIII in a Neoclassical building, purpose-built during 1837–47 by the architect Mihály Pollack.
