








Bologna Follow-Up Group Work Programme 2024-2027

I. Introduction

For the implementation of the Tirana Communiqué, at the meeting in Budapest, the BFUG adopted the Work Programme for the 2024-2027 period, which includes the list of working structures, their contribution to the commitments of the Tirana Communiqué and the list of cochairs. The co-chairs will prepare the Terms of Reference for their working structures, which will then be adopted by the BFUG in November 2024.
