




Recognition in the EHEA

- Key Commitment (along with 3 cycle Degree Structures, and Quality Assurance)
- Major factor in coherent European development and internationalisation



RECOGNITION: impact of Lisbon Recognition Convention



5 Principles:

- 1) applicants have right to fair assessment;
- 2) recognition if no **substantial differences** can be proven;
- 3) legislation encourages comparing of **learning outcomes** rather than programme contents;
- 4) in cases of negative decisions the recognition authority **demonstrates substantial difference**;
- 5) applicant's right to appeal

Recurrent problem:

legislation and institutional reality do not always match




Lisbon Recognition Convention: progress since 2018






RECOGNITION: Article VII of Lisbon Recognition Convention



Each Party shall.. develop procedures designed to assess fairly and expeditiously whether refugees, displaced persons and persons in a refugee-like situation fulfil the relevant requirements for access to higher education, to further higher education programmes or to employment activities, even in cases in which the qualifications obtained in one of the Parties cannot be proven through documentary evidence.



System-level automatic recognition

Conclusions

- Legal reality mostly (but not entirely) in place
- But is institutional practice always aligned with legal requirements?
- System level (automatic) recognition becoming normalized
